CONDITIONS OF SALE

These conditions shall govern all sales of goods by Richmond Marine Limited or Richmond Marine Developments Ltd. ("the Seller") unless expressly excluded by the written agreement of the Seller and the Purchaser. These conditions are subject to the provisions of the Unfair Contract Terms Act 1977 and paragraph 1 and 2 of these conditions shall not apply where the Purchaser "deals as a consumer" within the meaning of the Act.

- Where any goods supplied by the Seller are found to be defective as a result of bad workmanship or faulty
 materials, the Seller will, provided the defective goods are returned to it carriage paid within six (6) months
 from the date of despatch from our works, at its cost and at its own option either repair or replace the defective
 goods.
- Subject as aforesaid, all conditions other than conditions as to title, warranties and representations whether
 expressed or implied, statutory or otherwise, relating to goods supplied by the Selier, are hereby excluded and
 the Seller shall have no liability in respect of defective goods, whether on account of the Seller's negligence or
 otherwise.
- 3. Where a period is named for delivery and such period is not extended by mutual consent in writing by the Seller and Purchaser, the Purchaser shall take delivery within that period.
- 4. Any time or date for delivery or variations in the same named by the Seller is an estimate only, and the Seller shall not be liable for the consequences of any delay, whether or not the time or the date or variation of the same was named prior to, at time of, or subsequent to the placing of the Purchaser's order, caused by circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Seller. Time is not and is not to become of the essence of the contract.
- 5. The title to the goods shall not pass to the Purchaser until the full amount of the purchase price is paid.
- 6. A remittance in full payment for goods requiring shipment should accompany the Purchaser's order. In certain circumstances the Seller will accept payment on the basis of cash against delivery of shipping documents or by way of a confirmed irrevocable letter of credit, payable at sight on a London Bank.
- 7. Where any part of the purchase price remains outstanding, whether or not by prior arrangement with the Seller, the Seller shall be entitled to retain possession of the goods and to insure them up to their full value in the joint names of the Seller and the Purchaser and at the Purchaser's expense, until payment in full is made.
- 8. Although the Seller will endeavour to comply with any directions as to dates or methods of delivery given by the Purchaser, the Seller can accept no liability for delay in delivery or for any failure to deliver on or by any specific ship, plane or route, caused in any such case by circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Seller.
- Any loss or deterioration of or damage to the goods, caused otherwise than by the negligence of the Seller shall
 be borne by the Purchaser from the moment when they are issued from the Seller's works or from the Seller's
 export packers where applicable.
- 10. The cost of storage whether on the Seller's premises or elsewhere, as a result of any delay on the part of the Purchaser in collection of or acceptance of delivery of or payment for the goods, shall be to the account of the Purchaser.
- 11. The Purchaser shall not manufacture or cause to be manufactured or assist or enable any third party to manufacture or cause to be manufactured any boat, the design, shape, materials or method of manufacture of which is based on or substantially resembles that of a boat supplied to the Purchaser by the Seller.
- 12. The Seller reserves the right to make alterations to specifications without prior notice to the Purchaser.
- 13. The Price agreed between the Seller and the Purchaser shall be subject to variation where there occurs an increase in freight charges incurred because of variations in rates in exchange, or for any other reason, or whether there occurs any other increase beyond the control of the Seller in production or delivery costs, between the date of the contract and the date of despatch of the goods to the Purchaser, and such increases shall be borne by the Purchaser exclusively.
- 14. Accounts overdue for more than 30 days will be subject to an interest charge of 1½% per month to be paid on demand by the Purchaser to the Seller.
- 15. All contracts for or payment for the sale of goods by the Seller shall be governed by and construed according to English law. In cases where the Purchaser is resident outside the United Kingdom the parties submit to the jurisdiction of the High Court of England in relation to any dispute arising out of or in connection with any contract for the same of goods.
